SECTION 1. G.S. 20-183.8A reads as rewritten:	
"§ 20-183.8A. Civil penalties against motorists for emissions violations.	
The Division shall assess a civil penalty against a person who owns or leases a	
vehicle that is subject to an emissions inspection and who does any of the following:	
(1	Fails to have the vehicle inspected within four months after it is required to be inspected under this Part. The civil penalty for a violation of this subdivision is twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
