A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM IN THE HUMANITIES
AND HUMAN VALUES AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one hundred eighteen thousand dollars (\$118,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to support its Program in the Humanities and Human Values. The Program in the Humanities and Human Values, a unit of the College of Arts and Sciences, sponsors public programs which draw on the humanities to nurture a deeper understanding of our history and culture, enrich the life of the mind, and contribute to the development of a more humane world. The funds appropriated and allocated by this section shall be credited to the regular instructional budget of the College of Arts and Sciences.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
