Short Title: Innovative Teacher Compensation Initiative. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Swindell; Atwater and Malone. Referred to: Appropriations/Base Budget. March 26, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP A FRAMEWORK FOR AN INNOVATIVE TEACHER COMPENSATION INITIATIVE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The State Board of Education shall develop a framework for an innovative teacher compensation initiative that will support selected pilot local school administrative units' efforts to reward their most dynamic, innovative, and effective teachers with additional financial compensation. The framework shall provide the broad guidelines within which selected pilot units will develop specific plans for awarding supplemental pay and bonuses tied directly to criteria representing the areas of student growth, teacher knowledge and skills, teacher performance, and labor-market

13 conditions.

The framework shall require pilot units to develop individualized proposals
developed through demonstrated collaboration with local stakeholders including, but not
limited to, teachers, school-based administrators, and parents.

17 The Board shall develop a process through which units may apply to 18 participate in the pilot program, which will be limited to five units in fiscal year 19 2008-2009. The selection process shall take into account such factors as:

- (1) Innovativeness of plan;
- (2) A unit's ability to generate local revenue for appropriation to public schools;

- (3) The degree to which relevant stakeholders have participated in development of plan; and
- 25 (4) Geography.

The Board shall deliver a draft proposed framework to the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by October 15, 2007, and a final proposal to the same committee by December 15, 2007.

3 **SECTION 2.** It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide funds to 4 support implementation of the innovative teacher compensation pilots in the 2008-2009 5 fiscal year.
