#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE TYPES OF CONTRACTS THE DIVISION OF MOTOR
VEHICLES MAY ENTER INTO FOR THE PURPOSES OF ISSUING LICENSE
PLATES THROUGH PRIVATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITIES.

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-63(h) reads as rewritten:

7 Commission Contracts for Issuance of Plates and Certificates. - All "(h) 8 registration plates, registration certificates, and certificates of title issued by the Division, outside of those issued from the Raleigh and Charlotte offices of the Division 9 10 and those issued and handled through the United States mail, shall be issued insofar as 11 practicable and possible through commission contracts entered into by the Division for the issuance of the plates and certificates in localities throughout North Carolina with 12 13 persons, firms, corporations or governmental subdivisions of the State of North 14 Carolina. The Division shall make a reasonable effort in every locality, except as noted 15 above, to enter into a commission contract for the issuance of the plates and certificates 16 and a record of these efforts shall be maintained in the Division. The Division shall 17 make every effort to enter into a contract with a person, firm, corporation, or any other legal entity before entering into a contract with a governmental subdivision of the State. 18 19 In the event the Division is unsuccessful in making commission contracts, it shall issue 20 the plates and certificates through the regular employees of the Division. Division, provided the Division does not perform or cause to be performed any transactions, 21 provided for by this section, within a 15-mile radius of an existing private contract 22 location. Whenever registration plates, registration certificates, and certificates of title 23 24 are issued by the Division through commission contract arrangements, the Division 25 shall provide proper supervision of the distribution. Nothing contained in this subsection 26 will allow or permit the operation of fewer outlets in any county in this State than are 27 now being operated operated except that no less than 100 nongovernmental private outlet contracts shall remain in effect throughout the State with a minimum of one 28 29 private outlet contract in each county.

"(i) Electronic Applications and Collections. – The Division is authorized to
accept electronic applications for the issuance of registration plates, registration
certificates, and certificates of title, and to electronically collect fees and penalties.title.
The Division, and any commission contractor, is authorized to electronically collect fees
and penalties."
SECTION 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
