Short Title: Education Recovery Act of 2007.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO ENACT THE EDUCATION RECOVERY ACT OF 2007. 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. This act shall be known as "The Education Recovery Act of 4 5 2007". 6 **SECTION 2.(a)** The State Board of Education shall develop a framework 7 for an Education Recovery Pilot Program. The purpose of the Education Recovery Pilot 8 Program is to provide a financial incentive to students to improve their academic 9 performance. 10 Under the pilot program, every student will be given one thousand dollars (\$1,000) at the beginning of each school year from grade one through grade 12. The 11 12 money will be placed in an investment account managed by the Office of the State 13 Treasurer. The students may use the money only for postsecondary education. 14 To retain the full one thousand dollars (\$1,000), the student and the student's parent or guardian will have to meet academic, disciplinary, attendance, character, and 15 16 other goals. Failure to meet the goals will result in the forfeiture of funds. 17 Upon graduation, the student will have a maximum of twelve thousand 18 dollars (\$12,000) plus interest to help pay for higher education. Students who enter the teaching profession and remain in North Carolina to 19 teach will receive a bonus. 20 21 **SECTION 2.(b)** The State Board of Education shall develop a process through which local school administrative units may apply to participate in the pilot 22 23 program, which will be limited to five units for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. 24 **SECTION 2.(c)** The Board shall deliver a draft proposed framework to the 25 Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee by October 15, 2007, and a final 26 proposal to the same committee by December 15, 2007.

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SECTION 3. It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide funds for
the 2008-2009 fiscal year to implement the Education Recovery Pilot Program.
SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
