2	AN ACT TO ALLOW EARTHDOG TRIALS.		
3	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 14-362.2 reads as rewritten:		
5	"§ 14-362.2. Dog fighting and baiting.		
6	(a) A person who instigates, promotes, conducts, is employed at, provides a dog		
7	for, allows property under the person's ownership or control to be used for, gambles on,		
8	or profits from an exhibition featuring the baiting of a dog or the fighting of a dog with		
9	another dog or with another animal is guilty of a Class H felony. A lease of property		
10	that is used or is intended to be used for an exhibition featuring the baiting of a dog or		
11	the fighting of a dog with another dog or with another animal is void, and a lessor who		
12	2 knows this use is made or is intended to be made of the lessor's property is under a duty		
13	to evict the lessee immediately.		
14	(b) A person who owns, possesses, or trains a dog with the intent that the dog be		
15	used in an exhibition featuring the baiting of that dog or the fighting of that dog with		
16	another dog or with another animal is guilty of a Class H felony.		
17	(c) A person who participates as a spectator at an exhibition featuring the baiting		
18	of a dog or the fighting of a dog with another dog or with another animal is guilty of a		
19	Class H felony.		
20	(d) This section does not prohibit the use of dogs in the lawful taking of animals

22	(e) This section does not prohibit the use of dogs in earthdog trials that are		
23	sanctioned or sponsored by entities approved by the Commissioner of Agriculture that		
24	meet standards that protect the health and safety of the dogs. Quarry at an earthdog trial		
25	shall at all times be kept separate from the dogs by a sturdy barrier, such as a cage, and		
26	5 <u>have access to food and water.</u> "

1 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to 2 offenses committed on or after that date. The Commissioner of Agriculture may take 3 action before that date to approve entities as permitted by G.S. 14-362.2(e) as enacted 4 by this act.
