5	Whereas, attorneys appointed to represent indigent defendants and
6	respondents are critical components of a fair and effective justice system; and
7	Whereas, the General Assembly has given the Commission on Indigent
8	Defense Services ("IDS") the statutory authority to set compensation rates for attorneys
9	appointed to represent indigent persons; and
10	Whereas, in 2002, IDS established the current rate of \$65.00 per hour for
11	noncapital cases; and
12	Whereas, State and national surveys indicates that current overhead operating
13	costs of a law practice range between \$51.00 and \$65.00 per hour and that those
14	overhead costs are paid by private attorneys out of the \$65.00 per hour IDS rate they
15	earn; and
16	Whereas, the salaries of State employees, including defenders, prosecutors,
17	judges, and other court system employees, have increased by 10.2% since IDS was
18	established and 7.5% in the last two years alone, but the noncapital \$65.00 per hour rate
19	has remained the same; and
20	Whereas, IDS has insufficient funds to raise the hourly rate without an
21	increased appropriation; and
22	Whereas, a \$10.00 increase in the noncapital IDS rate will strengthen the
23	effectiveness and fairness of our justice system for all North Carolinians; Now,
24	therefore,
25	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
26	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of
27	Indigent Defense Services the sum of eight million five hundred forty-one thousand five

1 hundred twenty-eight dollars (\$8,541,528) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of 2 eight million nine hundred ninety-four thousand two hundred twenty-eight dollars 3 (\$8,994,228) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to fund an increase by the Commission on 4 Indigent Defense Services of the noncapital hourly rate paid to attorneys appointed to 5 represent indigent persons from sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) per hour to seventy-five 6 dollars (\$75.00) per hour. 7

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
