7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
9	"§ 115C-47. Powers and duties generally.
10	In addition to the powers and duties designated in G.S. 115C-36, local boards of
11	education shall have the power or duty:

13	(45) To Ensure That Certain Students Receive Annual Health Instruction
14	Including Information on Lawfully Abandoning a Newborn Baby. –
15	Local boards of education shall adopt policies to ensure that students
16	in grades nine through 12 receive annual health instruction including
17	information on the manner in which a parent may lawfully abandon a
18	newborn baby with a responsible person, in accordance with
19	<u>G.S. 7B-500.</u> "
20	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
