A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO INCREASE THE LEGISLATIVE TUITION GRANTS FOR NORTH
CAROLINA RESIDENTS ENROLLED IN QUALIFIED, NONPROFIT, PRIVATE
COLLEGES OR UNIVERSITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of thirteen million four hundred
eighty-four thousand four hundred dollars (\$13,484,400) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year
to provide an increase in the legislative tuition grants to aid students attending private
colleges. The funds appropriated by this section shall be disbursed in accordance with
G.S. 116-21.2 through G.S. 116-22.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
