**SECTION 1.** Article 27A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

## "§ 14-208.18. Sexual predator prohibited from living with minor children.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person required to register under this Article to reside in a household with any minor child.
- (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, it shall not be unlawful for a person required to register under this Article to reside in a household with a minor, provided that the registrant is the blood parent of the minor, and the convicted offense was not against that minor.
- 15 (c) This section shall not in any way affect conditions of probation as provided 16 by G.S. 15A-1343, or conditions of post-release supervision as provided by 17 G.S. 15A-1368.4.
  - (d) A violation of this section is a Class F felony."
- SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
