1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3	HUMAN SERVICES FOR OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE ASSISTANCE
4	TO SMALL RURAL HOSPITALS.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7	Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Rural Health and Community
8	Care, the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These
9	funds shall be allocated to small rural hospitals in need of assistance with the operations
10	and infrastructure maintenance of the hospital. These funds may be used for:
11	(1) Capital and operational needs of small rural hospitals. The Office of
12	Rural Health and Community Care shall convene an advisory group to
13	establish criteria for distribution of these funds. The criteria shall
14	include the number of indigent patients served, the number of
15	Medicaid recipients served, the per capita income of the area served by
16	the hospital, and the financial needs of the hospital; and
17	(2) Pilot demonstration programs that address issues critical to the
18	long-term survivability of rural hospitals such as: development of
19	regional care networks for mental health services; restructuring of
20	emergency department and outpatient services; and disease-focused
21	regional referral and care networks. The Office of Rural Health and
22	Community Care shall convene an advisory group to establish criteria
23	for the pilot demonstration projects, distribution of funds, and
24	monitoring and evaluation of the pilot projects.
25	The Office of Rural Health and Community Care shall report on the
26	allocation of funds appropriated under this section to the Senate Appropriations
27	Committee on Health and Human Services, the House of Representatives
