There is appropriated from the General Fund to the SECTION 1. Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for the implementation of messages and materials for an ongoing safe Sleep Awareness campaign, which will highlight safe sleep practices to aid in the Sudden Syndrome prevention of Infant Death (SIDS) and accidental suffocation/strangulation.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
