THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL TO EXPAND
MEDICAL EDUCATION IN NORTH CAROLINA.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to conduct a feasibility study to plan East Carolina University's participation in a partnership with the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill to expand medical education in North Carolina.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
