2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3	HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF MENTAL HEALTH, DEVELOPMENTAL
4	DISABILITIES, AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES, FOR EXPANSION OF
5	THE ADULT DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY DAY SERVICE PILOT
6	PROGRAM.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
9	Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental
10	Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of one million five hundred
11	thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used
12	to expand the Community Based Developmental Disability Day Service Pilot model
13	from three community rehabilitation programs (CRP) to eight CRP programs. CRPs
14	piloting the new model will provide services to specified State-funded consumers at a
15	fixed monthly rate.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008. 16
