A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF MEDICAL

EXAMINER TO ADDRESS THE BACKLOG OF AUTOPSIES AS

RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE IN EMERGENCY

PREPAREDNESS AND DISASTER MANAGEMENT RECOVERY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner of the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one million four hundred sixteen thousand six hundred sixty-six dollars (\$1,416,666) in recurring funds for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to reduce autopsy time to 30 to 45 days, to improve the ability to detect and respond to emerging threats, and to improve support for mass casualties regionally.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
