A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO RAISE THE FUNDING CAP ON CHILDREN RECEIVING  
2 SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR ACADEMICALLY OR INTELLECTUALLY  
3 GIFTED CHILDREN, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE  
4 STUDY COMMITTEE ON PUBLIC SCHOOL FUNDING FORMULAS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
7 Department of Public Instruction the sum of three million nine hundred ninety-seven  
8 thousand three hundred ninety dollars (\$3,997,390) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to  
9 raise the funding cap on children receiving supplemental funding for academically or  
10 intellectually gifted children. Each local school administrative unit shall receive funds  
11 for a maximum of four and twenty-five one hundredths percent (4.25%) of its  
12 2008-2009 allocated average daily membership, regardless of the number of children  
13 identified as academically or intellectually gifted in the unit.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
