2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE PREVENTION OF ADOLESCENT
3 PREGNANCIES AND THE PREVENTION OF SCHOOL DROPOUT DUE TO
4 ADOLESCENT PREGNANCIES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** These is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7 Department of Health and Human Services the sum of one million one hundred
8 seventy-eight thousand dollars (\$1,178,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year for parenting
9 programs that keep pregnant and parenting students from dropping out of school. These
10 funds shall be used to increase individual local grants from forty-seven thousand nine
11 hundred eighty dollars (\$47,980) to sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) and be used to
12 provide funds for 10 new programs or grants to counties with the highest teen birthrates
13 and highest dropout rates.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
