A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 2008 REGULAR SESSION OF THE 2007 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO CONSIDER AN ACT TO MODERNIZE THE RECORD KEEPING OF PRECIOUS METALS PURCHASES BY DEALERS AND TO SUBJECT ALL DEALERS IN PRECIOUS METALS TO THE SAME LICENSING AND RECORD-KEEPING REQUIREMENTS BY REPEALING THE "TEN PERCENT OR LESS OF PURCHASES" EXEMPTION FROM DEALER PERMITTING AND REGULATION.

8 Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

SECTION 1. The 2007 General Assembly, Regular Session 2008, may 9 10 consider "AN ACT TO MODERNIZE THE RECORD KEEPING OF PRECIOUS METALS PURCHASES BY DEALERS AND TO SUBJECT ALL DEALERS IN 11 PRECIOUS METALS TO THE SAME LICENSING AND RECORD-KEEPING 12 13 REQUIREMENTS BY REPEALING THE "TEN PERCENT OR LESS OF **EXEMPTION** 14 PURCHASES" **FROM** DEALER PERMITTING **AND** 15 REGULATION."

SECTION 2. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
