A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CHARLOTTE HAWKINS BROWN
MUSEUM AT THE PALMER MEMORIAL INSTITUTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the
2007-2008 fiscal year for the Charlotte Hawkins Brown Museum at the Palmer
Memorial Institute State Historic Site. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$800,000 to provide furnishings for the museum, auditorium,
research/resource library and to provide audio and visual equipment
for the viewing rooms and interpretive areas.
- (2) \$200,000 to hire a professional facilities planner to assess the
capacities and capability of campus facilities for a variety of uses,
including community and economic development activities,
educational outreach centers, and meeting spaces.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
