6 7 **INTRODUCTION** 8 **SECTION 1.** The appropriations made in this act are for maximum amounts necessary to provide the services and accomplish the purposes described in the budget. 9 Savings shall be effected where the total amounts appropriated are not required to 10 perform these services and accomplish these purposes and, except as allowed by the 11 Executive Budget Act, or this act, the savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the 12 end of each fiscal year. 13 14

15 TITLE OF ACT

APPROPRIATIONS ACT OF 2007.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

PART I. INTRODUCTION AND TITLE OF ACT

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall be known as the "Current Operations 17 Appropriations and Capital Improvements Appropriations Act of 2008".

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19 PART II. CURRENT OPERATIONS AND EXPANSION/GENERAL FUND

SECTION 3. Appropriations from the General Fund of the State for the maintenance of the State departments, institutions, and agencies, and for other purposes, shall be made for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2008, in accordance with the provisions of this act. Modifications of the State budget may affect the appropriations of the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of State government for the 2008-2009 fiscal year.

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3	SECTION 4. Appropriations from the Highway Fund of the State for the
4	maintenance and operation of the Department of Transportation, and for other purposes,
5	shall be made for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, in accordance with the
6	provisions of this act.
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8	PART IV. HIGHWAY TRUST FUND
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10	SECTION 5. Appropriations from the Highway Trust Fund shall be made
11	for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, according to the provisions of this act.
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13	PART V. OTHER MODIFICATIONS
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15	SECTION 6. Any other modifications of the biennial State budget and other
16	changes related to the fiscal operations of the State shall be included in this act.
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18	PART VI. EFFECTIVE DATE
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20	SECTION 7. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
