A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE  
2 UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO PLAN, DESIGN, AND  
3 CONSTRUCT A JOINT PRIMARY DATA CENTER THAT IS A  
4 COLLABORATIVE PROJECT OF NORTH CAROLINA AGRICULTURAL AND  
5 TECHNICAL STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH  
6 CAROLINA AT GREENSBORO.

8 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

9 **SECTION 1.(a)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board  
10 of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of forty-six million three  
11 hundred thousand four hundred dollars for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. The funds shall  
12 be used as follows:

13 (1) The sum of four million six hundred thirty thousand forty dollars  
14 (\$4,630,040) shall be used to plan and design the facility that will  
15 house the University of North Carolina at Greensboro/North Carolina  
16 Agricultural and Technical State University Joint Primary Data Center,  
17 a collaborative initiative that may be located on the South Campus of  
18 the Gateway University Research Park.

19 (2) The sum of forty-one million six hundred seventy thousand three  
20 hundred sixty dollars (\$41,670,360) shall be used to construct the  
21 facility that will house the University of North Carolina at  
22 Greensboro/North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State  
23 University Joint Primary Data Center.

24 **SECTION 1(b).** The Board of Governors of The University of North  
25 Carolina may grant the funds appropriated to the Board of Governors by this section to  
26 Gateway University Research Park, Inc., to be used as provided by this section and in  
27 compliance with State law regarding grants to non-State entities.

28 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
