A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THE COUNTY OF BRUNSWICK THE AUTHORITY TO USE THE POWER OF EMINENT DOMAIN PURSUANT TO THE CONDEMNATION PROCESS SET OUT IN ARTICLE 9 OF CHAPTER 136 OF THE GENERAL STATUTES FOR THE ACQUISITION OF LAND ON A SINGLE HIGHWAY TO BE USED FOR THE PUBLIC PURPOSE OF IMPROVING THE ROAD AND PROVIDING NEEDED LAND AND EASEMENTS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO MAINTAIN THE ROAD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The County of Brunswick may use the power of eminent domain pursuant to the condemnation procedures set out in Article 9 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes to acquire private lands along a single highway for the public purpose of improving the highway and providing needed land for public and utility easements for the Department of Transportation to adopt and maintain roadways and the rights-of-way.

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
