2 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE CRAVEN COUNTY REGIONAL
3 AIRPORT AUTHORITY, TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE CRAVEN
4 COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT, AND TO ADD NONVOTING MEMBERS TO
5 THE AIRPORT AUTHORITY.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** Sections 1 and 7 of Chapter 1197 of the Session Laws of 1979,
8 as amended by Section 1.1 of S.L. 1989-1046, is amended by deleting "Craven County
9 Regional Airport Authority" and substituting "Coastal Carolina Regional Airport
10 Authority."

11 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 1197 of the Session Laws of 1979, as amended by
12 Chapter 838, Session Laws of 1985 and Section 1.2 of S.L. 1989-1046, is amended by
13 deleting "Craven County Regional Airport," wherever that phrase appears, and
14 substituting "Coastal Carolina Regional Airport."

15 **SECTION 3.** Section 2(a) of Chapter 1197 of the Session Laws of 1979, as
16 amended by Chapter 838, Session Laws of 1985 and Section 1(a) of S.L. 2005-14, reads
17 as rewritten:

18 "(a) The Airport Authority shall consist of eight voting members, all of whom
19 shall be residents of Craven County. The Commanding ~~General-Officer~~ of the United
20 States Marine Corps Air Station, Cherry Point, North Carolina, or the ~~General's~~
21 Commanding Officer's designee may serve as a nonvoting ~~Honorary Member-member~~
22 of the Authority. Further, the Board of Commissioners of Jones County may appoint a
23 nonvoting member to serve on the Airport Authority, the Board of Commissioners of
24 Pamlico County may appoint a nonvoting member to serve on the Airport Authority,
25 and the Board of Commissioners of Carteret County may appoint a nonvoting member
26 to serve on the Airport Authority."

27 **SECTION 4.** Section 6(a) of Chapter 1197 of the Session Laws of 1979
28 reads as rewritten:

1 "(a) The Airport Authority shall appoint from its voting members a Chairman, Vice
2 Chairman, and other officers as it may deem necessary for the orderly conduct of its
3 business. A majority of the voting members shall control the decisions of the Airport
4 Authority, and each voting member of the the Airport Authority, including the
5 Chairman shall have one vote. A majority of the duly appointed and qualified voting
6 members of the Airport Authority shall constitute a quorum."

7 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
