A JOINT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE 2007 GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO CONSIDER A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF SIMPLE ASSAULT A FELONY RATHER THAN A MISDEMEANOR WHEN THE SIMPLE ASSAULT IS COMMITTED AGAINST A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A FIREFIGHTER, OR EMERGENCY PERSONNEL.

7 Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

8 **SECTION 1.** The 2007 General Assembly may consider "A BILL TO BE 9 ENTITLED AN ACT TO MAKE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF SIMPLE 10 ASSAULT A FELONY RATHER THAN A MISDEMEANOR WHEN THE SIMPLE 11 ASSAULT IS COMMITTED AGAINST A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER, A EIREFICHTER OF EMERGENCY PERSONNEL."
