A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DIVISION OF PUBLIC HEALTH, FOR CHRONIC DISEASE AND PREVENTION CONTROL ACTIVITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of four million two hundred eighty-seven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$4,287,700) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of four million two hundred eighty-seven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$4,287,700) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to expand statewide capacity for chronic disease prevention and control.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
