4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 14-415.1(a) reads as rewritten:
6	"(a) It shall be unlawful for any person who has been convicted of a felony to
7	purchase, own, possess, or have in his custody, care, or control any firearm or any
8	weapon of mass death and destruction as defined in G.S. 14-288.8(c). For the purposes
9	of this section, a firearm is (i) any weapon, including a starter gun, which will or is
10	designed to or may readily be converted to expel a projectile by the action of an
11	explosive, or its frame or receiver, or (ii) any firearm muffler or firearm silencer. This
12	section does not apply to an antique firearm, as defined in G.S. 14-409.11.
13	Every person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished as a Class $G-F$
14	felon."
15	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to
16	offenses committed on or after that date.
