Use of likenesses of any sea  (a) Whoever, except as directed  Senate on its behalf, knowingly uses, may resale, either separately or appended to any seal or coat of arms of the Senate manufacture or sale of the article for the obe guilty of a Class 2 misdemeanor.  (b) A violation of this section manufacture.  SECTION 2.
