7	SECTION 1. G.S. 90-171.23(b) is amended by adding the following new		
8	subdivisions:		
9	"(b)	Dutie	s, powers. The Board is empowered to:

11		(21)	Conduct administrative hearings in accordance with Article 3A of
12			Chapter 150B of the General Statutes when a contested case, as
13			defined in G.S. 150B-2(2), arises under this Article. Notwithstanding
14			G.S. 150B-40(b), the Board, at its discretion, may conduct hearings
15			consisting of less than a majority of the Board or greater than a
16			majority of the Board, and the majority of those members conducting
17			the hearing shall be licensed nurses.
18		<u>(22)</u>	Designate one or more of its employees to serve papers or subpoenas
19			issued by the Board. Service under this subdivision is in addition to
20			any other methods of service permitted by law.
21		<u>(23)</u>	Acquire, hold, rent, encumber, alienate, and otherwise deal with real
22			property in the same manner as a private person or corporation, subject
23			only to approval of the Governor and the Council of State. Collateral
24			pledged by the Board for an encumbrance is limited to the assets,
25			income, and revenues of the Board."
26		SECT	FION 2. G.S. 90-171.56(1) reads as rewritten:
27		"(1)	Establish standards for faculty and applicant requirements for
28			medication aide training; and training."
29		SECT	FION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
