A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO LIMIT THE RULES THAT MAY BE ADOPTED BY THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT COMMISSION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 143-214.1(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Chapter 150B of the General Statutes governs the adoption and publication of rules under this Article. The Commission may not adopt rules that condition the granting of any permit, approval, or certification on the fulfillment of a requirement that is beyond the authority of the applicant and that is within the authority of someone other than the applicant."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
