SECTION 1. G.S. 143-211(c) reads as rewritten:

It is the purpose of this Article to create an agency which shall administer a 7 "(c) 8 program of water and air pollution control and water resource management. It is the 9 intent of the General Assembly, through the duties and powers defined herein, to confer such authority upon the Department of Environment and Natural Resources as shall be 10 11 necessary to administer a complete program of water and air conservation, pollution abatement and control and to achieve a coordinated effort of pollution abatement and 12 13 control with other jurisdictions. Standards of water and air purity shall be designed to 14 protect human health, to prevent injury to plant and animal life, to prevent damage to 15 public and private property, to insure the continued enjoyment of the natural attractions 16 of the State, to encourage the expansion of employment opportunities, to provide a permanent foundation for healthy industrial development and to secure for the people of 17 North Carolina, now and in the future, the beneficial uses of these great natural 18 19 resources. It is the intent of the General Assembly that the powers and duties of the 20 Environmental Management Commission and the Department of Environment and 21 Natural Resources be construed so as to enable the Department and the Commission to 22 qualify to administer federally mandated programs of environmental management and 23 to qualify to accept and administer funds from the federal government for such 24 programs. It is also the intent of the General Assembly that neither the Environmental Management Commission nor the Department of Environment and Natural Resources 25 26 may impose as a condition of any permit, approval, or certification any requirement beyond the authority of the applicant of such permit, approval, or certification to satisfy 27 or any condition not specifically authorized by act of the General Assembly. 28

- 1 Additionally, no condition may be imposed on any permit, approval, or certification that
- 2 is not supported by a preponderance of evidence justifying its imposition."
- 3 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
