A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BREVARD IS  
ELECTED TO A FOUR-YEAR TERM.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** Section 2.2 of the Charter of the City of Brevard, being  
Chapter 415 of the 1981 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2.2. Mayor, Term of Office, Duties. The Mayor shall be elected by and from  
the qualified voters of the City for a term of ~~two~~-four years, in the manner provided by  
Article III of this Charter; provided, the Mayor shall serve until his successor is elected  
and qualified. The Mayor shall be the official head of the City government, shall preside  
at all meetings of the City Council, and shall have the powers and duties of Mayor as  
prescribed by this Charter and the General Statutes. The Mayor shall have the right to  
vote on matters before the Council only where there are an equal number of votes in the  
affirmative and in the negative."

**SECTION 2.** This act applies beginning with the Mayor elected in 2009.
