5	SEC	TION 1. G.S. 20-7(f) reads as rewritten:		
6	"(f) Dura	tion and Renewal of Licenses Drivers licenses shall be issued and		
7	renewed pursuant to the provisions of this subsection.			
8	(1)	Duration of license for persons under age 18. – A full provisional		
9		license issued to a person under the age of 18 shall expire on the		
10	<i>(</i> -)	person's twenty-first birthday.		
11	(2)	Duration of license for persons at least 18 years of age or older. – A		
12		drivers license issued to a person at least 18 years old but less than $\frac{54}{54}$		
13		$\underline{65}$ years old expires eight years after the date of issuance. A drivers		
14		license issued to a person at least <u>54–65</u> years old expires five years		
15	(2)	after the date of issuance.		
16 17	(3)	Duration of license. – A drivers license that was issued by the Division		
17		and is renewed by the Division expires at the end of the period provided by this subsection after the expiration date of the license that		
18 19		is renewed unless the Division determines that a license of shorter		
20		duration should be issued when the applicant holds a visa of limited		
20		duration from the United States Department of Homeland Security, but		
22		in no event shall the license expire later than the applicant's lawful		
23		presence in the United States. A person may apply to the Division to		
24		renew a license during the 180-day period before the license expires.		
25		The Division may not accept an application for renewal made before		
26		the 180-day period begins.		
27	(4)	Renewal by mail. – The Division may renew by mail a drivers license
