A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE CAPITAL FUNDS TO HOSPICE OF WAKE  
COUNTY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HOSPICE AND PALLIATIVE  
CARE CENTER IN WAKE COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Hospice of Wake County, Inc., the sum of two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to supplement other funds obtained by Hospice of Wake County for the construction of a hospice and palliative care center in Wake County. Any unencumbered and unexpended funds on June 30, 2008, from this appropriation shall not revert to the General Fund but shall remain with Hospice of Wake County, Inc., to be used for the purpose authorized in this section.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
