February 12, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF ASSIGNMENTS TO THE SPECIAL ASSISTANCE IN-HOME PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA STUDY COMMISSION ON AGING. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Funds appropriated to the Department of Health and Human Services for the 2007-2008 fiscal year may be used to increase the maximum number of assignments to special assistance in-home program to 2,000 persons. **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
