Short Title: Rutherford Referendum. (Local) **Sponsors:** Senator Dalton. Referred to: State & Local Government. March 12, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING RUTHERFORD COUNTY TO CONDUCT AN ADVISORY REFERENDUM ON A HIGH IMPACT LAND-USE ORDINANCE. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The board of commissioners of a county may direct the board of elections of that county to conduct an advisory referendum on a high impact land-use ordinance. **SECTION 2.** The board of commissioners shall decide the form and content of the issue on the ballot and define the area that will be voting. SECTION 3. Any referendum under this act must be conducted during 2007.

SECTION 4. This section applies to Rutherford County only.

SECTION 5. This act is effective when it becomes law.
