1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR FUNDING FOR THE STATEWIDE SPAY AND
3	NEUTER PROGRAM FROM THE SALE OF RABIES VACCINATION TAGS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 130A-190 reads as rewritten:
6	"§ 130A-190. Rabies vaccination tags.
7	(a) <u>Issuance. – A licensed veterinarian or a certified rabies vaccinator who</u>
8	administers rabies vaccine to a dog or cat shall issue a rabies vaccination tag to the
9	owner of the animal. The rabies vaccination tag shall show the year issued, a
10	vaccination number, the words "North Carolina" or the initials "N.C." and the words
11	"rabies vaccine." Dogs and cats shall wear rabies vaccination tags at all times. However,
12	cats may be exempted from wearing the tags by local ordinance.
13	(b) <u>Fee.</u> – Rabies vaccination tags, links and <u>links</u>, and <u>rivets</u> may be obtained
14	from the Department. The Secretary is authorized to establish by rule a fee for the rabies
15	tags, links and rivets. links, and rivets in accordance with this subsection. Except as
16	otherwise authorized in this section, the fee shall not exceed the actual cost of the rabies
17	tags, links and rivets, plus transportation costs. The Secretary may increase the fee
18	beyond the actual cost plus transportation, by an amount not to exceed five cents (\$.05)
19	per tag, to fund rabies education and prevention programs. The fee for each tag is the
20	sum of the following:
21	(1) The actual cost of the rabies tag, links, and rivets.
22	(2) <u>Transportation costs.</u>
23	(3) Five cents (5ϕ) . This portion of the fee shall be used to fund rabies
24	education and prevention programs.
25	(4) Twenty cents (20ϕ) . This portion of the fee shall be credited to the
26	Spay/Neuter Account established in G.S. 19A-62 and used to fund
27	statewide spay/neuter programs. This portion of the fee shall not be
28	imposed for tags provided to persons who operate establishments

1	primarily for the purpose of boarding or training hunting dogs or who
2	own and vaccinate 10 or more dogs per year.
3	(c) The Department shall make available a special edition rabies tag to be known
4	as the "I Care" tag. This tag shall be different in shape from the standard tag and shall
5	carry the inscription "I Care" in addition to the information required by subsection (a) of
6	this section. The Secretary is authorized to establish a fee for the "I Care" rabies tag
7	equal to the amount set forth in subsection (b) of this section plus an additional fifty
8	cents (\$.50). The additional fifty cents (\$.50) shall be credited to the Spay/Neuter
9	Account established in G.S. 19A-62."
10	SECTION 2. G.S. 19A-62 reads as rewritten:
11	"§ 19A-62. Spay/Neuter Account established.
12	(a) Creation. – The Spay/Neuter Account is established as a nonreverting special
13	revenue account in the Department of Health and Human Services. The Account
14	consists of the following:
15	(1) Fifty cents $(50¢)$ of the fee imposed by G.S. $130A-190(c)$ on the costs
16	of obtaining rabies vaccination tags. The portion of the fee imposed
17	under G.S. 130A-190(b)(4) for obtaining a rabies vaccination tag from
18	the Department of Health and Human Services.
19	(2) Ten dollars (\$10.00) of the additional fee imposed by G.S. 20-79.7 for
20	an Animal Lovers special license plate.
21	(3) Any other funds available from appropriations by the General
22	Assembly or from contributions and grants from public or private
23	sources.
24	(b) Use. – The revenue in the Account shall be used by the Department of Health
25	and Human Services as follows:
26	(1) If the revenue generated by the portion of the fee imposed under
27	G.S. 130A-190(b)(3) is less than forty-seven thousand five hundred
28	dollars (\$47,500) for the fiscal year, then funds up to the difference
29	between forty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$47,500) and the
30	amount of revenue generated may be used from this Account to fund
31	rabies education and prevention programs.
32	(2) Twenty percent (20%) shall be used to develop and implement the
33	statewide education program component of the Spay/Neuter Program
34	established in G.S. 19A-61(a).
35	(2)(3) Up to twenty percent (20%) of the money in the Account may be used
36	to defray the costs of administering the Spay/Neuter Program
37	established in this Article.
38	(3)(4) Funds remaining after deductions for the education program and
39	administrative expenses shall be distributed quarterly to eligible
40	counties and cities seeking reimbursement for reduced-cost
41	spay/neuter surgeries performed during the previous year. A county or
42	city is ineligible to receive funds under this subdivision unless it
43	requires the owner to show proof of rabies vaccination at the time of

1	the procedure or, if none, require vaccination at the time of the
2	procedure."
3	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 2008.
