A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO RESTORE FUNDING FOR ASSISTANT PRINCIPALS IN THE  
PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Instruction the sum of five million five hundred sixty-three thousand two hundred twenty-five dollars (\$5,563,225) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of five million six hundred twenty-three thousand four hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$5,623,497) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to allot assistant principal positions on the basis of one 10-month position per 761 average daily membership.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
