A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO CHANGE THE AGGRAVATING FACTOR RELATING TO HAVING
A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF TWELVE IN THE VEHICLE TO HAVING A
CHILD UNDER SIXTEEN IN THE VEHICLE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. G.S. 20-141.5(b)(8) reads as rewritten:

"§ 20-141.5. **Speeding to elude arrest.**

...

(b) If two or more of the following aggravating factors are present at the time the violation occurs, violation of this section shall be a Class H felony.

...

(8) Driving with a child under ~~12~~16 years of age in the vehicle."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
