5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
7	Community Colleges System Office the sum of fifty thousand one hundred
8	seventy-eight dollars (\$50,178) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of fifty
9	thousand one hundred seventy-eight dollars (\$50,178) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year for
10	the Spouse-to-Teacher Program, a lateral entry program for the spouses of military
11	personnel.
12	SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-296 is amended by adding a new subsection to
13	read:
14	"(c3) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (c1) of this section, an
15	individual participating in the Troops-to-Teachers Program or the Spouse-to-Teacher
16	Program for military personnel and their spouses may be certified as a teacher under the
17	community college lateral entry program regardless of whether the individual:
18	(1) Completed a bachelors degree at least five years before undertaking
19	the program of study,
20	(2) Holds a lateral entry teaching certificate, or
21	(3) Is employed as a teacher in a local school administrative unit."
22	SECTION 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007, and expires July 1,
23	2011.
