BILL SUMMARY: Creates GS 20-118.4 to exempt federal, state, and local government owned and operated overweight and oversized vehicles responding to fires, emergencies, or other disasters as determined by the Secretary of Crime Control and Public Safety or the Secretary of Transportation.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: There are no costs or loss of revenues associated with this act. Government entities currently do not pay a fee for the permit for their overweight and oversized vehicles responding to emergencies. These vehicles were required to have a permit; however, there was no fee associated with permitting. Through this act, these vehicles will be exempt from permitting and there will no loss of revenue.
