RALEIGH ENERGY EFFICIENCY.** Filed 3/5/09. *TO MAKE PERMANENT AN ACT EXEMPTING THE CITY OF RALEIGH FROM COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS WHEN LETTING CONTRACTS FOR USE AS PART OF ANY PILOT PROGRAM AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY COUNCIL TO TEST THE EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS OF LIGHT EMITTING DIODE TECHNOLOGIES, AND TO EXPAND THE ACT TO ALL RALEIGH PILOT PROGRAMS AIMED AT INCREASING ENERGY EFFICIENCY.*

Amends SL 2007-333 Section 1 as title indicates.

**H 464. RALEIGH ENERGY EFFICIENCY.** Filed 3/5/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Adds provision amending GS 160A-272 authorizing the city of Raleigh to authorize a lease for the siting and operation of a renewable energy facility for twenty years without treating it as a sale and without giving notice by publication. Makes a conforming change to the title.

**H 464. RALEIGH ENERGY EFFICIENCY.** Filed 3/5/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition. Adds Winston-Salem as the second city (the other is Raleigh) authorized to enter into a lease for the siting and operation of a renewable energy facility for up to 20 years without treating the lease as a sale of property and without giving notice by publication of the intended lease. Makes a conforming change to the title.
