H 1281. ELECTION DIRECTOR OVERSIGHT. Filed 4/8/09. *TO GRANT ADDITIONAL OVERSIGHT OF COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTION EMPLOYEES TO THE STATE BOARD OF ELECTIONS IN ORDER TO PROVIDE GREATER CONSISTENCY IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF ELECTIONS.*

Amends GS 163-35 to provide that, after the appointment of a nominee for director of elections by the Executive Director of the State Board of Elections, the county board of elections must enter in its official minutes the specified duties, responsibilities, and designated authority, *including the duty and responsibility to comply with all orders of the State Board and all directives issued by the Executive Director under GS 163-132.4.* Also provides that a resolution, adopted by majority vote of the county board of elections to delegate to its director of elections administrative detail of the election functions, duties, and work of the board, must require the director of elections to comply with all orders of the State Board and all directives issued by the Executive Director under GS 163-132.4. Effective July 1, 2009. Requires every county board of elections to amend or adopt the resolution of duties and responsibilities required by this act by January 1, 2010.

H 1281. ELECTION DIRECTOR OVERSIGHT. Filed 4/8/09. House committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition. Amends GS 163-33 to clarify that county boards of elections must perform duties imposed upon them by law and issue rules consistent with directives promulgated under the provisions of GS 163-132.4 or the rules, orders, and directives established by the State Board of Elections. Makes conforming changes to GS 163-35(b) and (d).

Senate committee substitute deletes the provisions of the 2nd edition and replaces it with *AN ACT TO ALLOW A FEDERAL DISTRICT COURT JUDGE TO PERFORM MARRIAGE CEREMONIES BETWEEN OCTOBER 14, 2010, AND OCTOBER 18, 2010.* Amends GS 51-1, as the title indicates.
