As title indicates. Requires the Task Force to report to the North Carolina Study Commission on Aging by October 15, 2010.

In addition to representatives listed in original bill, requires that the task force created to develop guidelines include a practicing audiologist and a physician who treats patients with hearing loss.

H 1705. CONSUMER GUIDELINES FOR HEARING AID PURCHASES. Filed 5/13/10. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 2nd edition.

Makes clarifying and linguistic changes to the list of Task Force members including requiring inclusion of a licensed hearing aid fitter and seller, and a hearing aid user. Requires the Hearing Aid Dealers and Fitters Board to report to the North Carolina Study Commission on Aging *and the Joint Legislative Health Care Oversight Committee* on or before November 15, 2010 (was October 15, 2010).
