S 499. EDGECOMBE/NO HUNTING ON THE LAND OF ANOTHER. Filed 3/10/09. *TO PROHIBIT HUNTING ON THE PROPERTY OF ANOTHER WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION IN EDGECOMBE COUNTY.*

Amends Section 4 of SL 2005-264 to include Edgecombe County among the counties in which hunting on another's property is prohibited without written permission. Effective for offenses committed on or after October 1, 2009.

S 499. EDGECOMBE/NO HUNTING ON THE LAND OF ANOTHER. Filed 3/10/09. Senate committee substitute makes the following changes to 1st edition.

Provides that it is unlawful to hunt on the land of another without having and carrying on one's person the written permission, signed and dated for the current hunting season by the landowner or lessee, or the landowner's or lessee's designee. Makes a violation of this act a Class 3 misdemeanor for a first offense and a Class 2 misdemeanor for a second or subsequent offense. Provides that the act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. Removes proposed amendment to Section 4 of SL 2005-264. Continues to apply only to Edgecombe County
