S 1028. ENCOURAGE VOLUNTEERISM IN SCHOOLS. Filed 3/26/09. *DIRECTING THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO ADOPT GUIDELINES AND POLICIES FOR CHARTERED COMMUNITY GROUPS TO TUTOR PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS.*

Amends GS 115C-206 to add a new subsection (b) as the title indicates. Directs the Superintendent of Public Instruction (Superintendent) to prepare recommendations for general guidelines for independent community efforts to provide volunteers to tutor students in public schools and to present those recommendations to the State Board of Education (SBE). Provides that the guidelines are to authorize a community group or other entity to adopt a charter committing itself to providing tutoring services. Prescribes the content of the charter. States that the guidelines are to encourage the commitment of all age groups to the volunteer tutoring effort, including retired citizens and college students. Directs the SBE to adopt the appropriate guidelines and policies to promote the independent community efforts to provide tutors for the public schools based on recommendations from the Superintendent.

Changes title to *AN ACT DIRECTING LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO ENCOURAGE COMMUNITY ACADEMIC BOOSTER ORGANIZATIONS, KNOWN AS COMMUNITY ACHIEVEMENT NETWORK-DEVELOPING OUR EDUCATION RESOURCES (CAN DOER) ORGANIZATIONS, TO SUPPORT STUDENT ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT, TO DEVELOP POLICIES APPROVING USE OF VOLUNTEER ORGANIZATIONS AND INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEERS, AND TO DEVELOP POLICIES TO MAKE INFORMATION ON TUTORING AND ACADEMIC SUPPORT SERVICES AVAILABLE TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS.* Completely deletes proposed amendment to GS 115C-206 directing the State Board of Education to adopt guidelines and policies for independent community efforts to provide volunteer tutors for public schools. Replaces it with proposed amendment of GS 115C-207 to require every local board of education that uses state funds to implement programs as title indicates.
