1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE LOCAL BOARDS OF EDUCATION TO LIMIT THE NUMBER OF 3 GRADE LEVELS IN HIGH SCHOOL SELF-CONTAINED SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASSROOMS, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION 4 5 OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 7 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-47 is amended by adding the following new subdivision 8 to read: "(53) To Limit the Number of Grade Levels in High-School Self-Contained 9 Special Education Classrooms. - Local boards of education shall adopt 10 policies requiring that no more than two grade levels may be combined in 11

self-contained special education classrooms for students in grades nine through 12."

SECTION 2. Part 1B of Article 9 of Chapter 115C of the General Statutes is

amended by adding the following new section to read:

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It shall be the duty of each local board of education to adopt policies requiring that no more than two grade levels may be combined in self-contained special education classrooms for students in grades nine through 12, as provided in G.S. 115C-47(53)."

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2009, and applies beginning with the 2010-2011 school year.
