10	"§ 115C-335.8. Certain school-based health services prohibited; parental consent required				
11	for referral of students age 16 and under to certain community health services.				
12	<u>(a)</u>		school administrative units shall not provide, directly or under contract with		
13	another p	oublic o	r private entity, psychological or reproductive health services to students age		
14			or shall they permit access to students entrusted to their care on the school		
15	grounds b		h care professionals who might provide these services.		
16	<u>(b)</u>		school administrative units shall not refer a student age 16 or under to a health		
17	care provider for psychological or reproductive health services without obtaining the prior				
18	written consent of the student's parent. The local school administrative unit shall obtain prior				
19	written consent for each proposed referral for psychological or reproductive health services.				
20	Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, a local school administrative unit may refer a				
21	student age 16 or under for psychological health services where the necessity for immediate				
22	treatment is so apparent that securing approval would delay the treatment so long as to				
23	endanger the life of the child, although the local school administrative unit shall immediately				
24	attempt to notify the parent and must notify the parent within 24 hours. The local school				
25	administrative unit may use a general consent form to obtain parental consent for health				
26	services other than psychological and reproductive health services. Such general consent form
