1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO ABOLISH THE CIVIL ACTIONS OF ALIENATION OF AFFECTION AND
3 CRIMINAL CONVERSATION.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
6 section to read:

7 "**§ 52-13. Abolition of alienation of affection cause of action.**

8 The common-law cause of action for alienation of affection of a spouse is abolished."

9 **SECTION 2.** Chapter 52 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
10 section to read:

11 "**§ 52-14. Abolition of criminal conversation cause of action.**

12 The common-law cause of action for criminal conversation is abolished."

13 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law. This act does not affect
14 cases pending when the act becomes law.
