Short Title: Local Govts Regulate Smoking/Public Places. (Public) Sponsors: Representatives M. Alexander; Harrison, Lucas, and Wray. Referred to: Health, if favorable, Judiciary I. April 8, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT AUTHORIZING LOCAL GOVERNMENTS TO ADOPT LAWS, RULES, OR ORDINANCES REGULATING SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 143-601 is repealed. **SECTION 2.** Article 64 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new section to read: "§ 143-602. Local governments may regulate smoking in public places. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article to the contrary, a local government may adopt an ordinance, law, or rule regulating smoking in public places."

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
