4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-304 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
6	"(a2) A fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) may be assessed in the discretion of the
7	court against a complainant who has caused the issuance of a criminal warrant or summons but
8	subsequently drops the charges or refuses to cooperate with the prosecution of the case, in order
9	to compensate the court for the time and expense of serving the warrant or summons, for the
10	scheduling of the case on the criminal docket, and for related expenses."
11	SECTION 2. The Administrative Office of the Courts shall (i) determine and
12	implement effective methods of notifying potential complainants that the issuance of a criminal
13	warrant obligates them to follow through and cooperate with the prosecution of the criminal
14	case they are initiating; and (ii) develop guidelines for judges in determining the appropriate
15	circumstances for assessing the fee authorized under this section.
16	SECTION 3. Section 1 of this act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and
17	applies to criminal warrants issued on and after that date. The remainder of this act is effective
18	when it becomes law.
